

Louise E. Liste 1916-2010 NILES - Louise E. Liste, 94, of Niles, died at 2:10 p.m. Friday, Dec. 31, 2010, at Autumn Hills Care Center surrounded by her loving family. She was born March 5, 1916, in Olyphant, Pa., a daughter of John and Mary Candella DeFalco.
